PRAYING FOR MUSLIMS

Belief in Jesus

Most Muslims believe Jesus was a great prophet, but only a prophet. Pray that Muslim people would turn away from false teachings and understand the truth of the Gospel and believe it. Pray they would seek after the Gospel wholeheartedly. **Pray Mark 8:27-29.**

Bible Translation Work

23 of the 70 people groups in Afghanistan do not have even Bible portions available in their primary language. Pray for translation efforts among Muslim people groups so every Muslim group can have access to understanding the Bible. **Pray Colossians 4:3.**

Revealing in Dreams

About 25% of Muslims' journey to faith begins with a dream. Pray that Jesus would reveal Himself to many Muslims in dreams today to show them that He is the only Way, Truth, and Life. Pray they will meet a believer and begin to seek Jesus. **Pray John 14:6.**

"God moved me to go overseas...by the tragic events that happened in Afghanistan. I was happy to hear that our team was going to serve in a nearby Central Asian country; however, I had no expectation of meeting any Afghans. To my surprise, God blessed me in the first week of our trip with opportunities to meet Muslims from Afghanistan. One of them was a student named Solomon. The events in his home country had made him question his Muslim faith, and he was curious about Christianity. He quickly became one of our closest friends as we shared our faith and our lives with him. though he still held on to his Muslim beliefs. After returning home, I tried to pray for him daily. About one month later. I received a text from our overseas host that Solomon had begun to read the Bible! I was so excited, and I told friends and family to pray for him. About a week later I woke up to the greatest text I've ever received-Solomon had become a brother in Christ! I was so thankful to God..."

Pray for women in the Muslim world who are struggling with abuse in the home. Pray that they would come to Jesus and He would be their strength. Pray their husbands will desire to learn about Jesus. **Pray 1 Peter 3:1-7.**

Radical Extremists

Islam is known for its radical extremists. God has a history of using people who were radically against Him to further His Kingdom. Pray for Jesus to change them like He did Paul. Pray they would be evangelists to their own peoples. **Pray 1 Timothy 1:15-16.**
