Costs related to OneLink Training for Stateside Partners

Application Fee \$25 Due upon application A non-refundable fee paid online by the applicant, at the time of application submission.

Commitment Fee \$75

Due December 20

Following acceptance, a non refundable fee paid by each participant to accept and commit to their project assignment.

Training Fee

\$500 Team Leader training. Due in two installments March 1 & May 1 This fee covers costs associated with OneLink orientation (O-Week) and Team Leader Training

Additional Logistics Support

(Optional) \$100/Student **Visa Service**: OneLink will manage the entire visa application process.

Arrange Airline Tickets: OneLink will coordinate air itinerary, negotiation and agreements. Stateside partners will give final approval before and send payment directly after ticket purchase.

Arrange Insurance: OneLink will coordinate enrolling team members in Gallagher insurance.
